Special Education

What is Special Education?

Special Education is instruction designed to meet the unique learning and needs of the individual student with disabilities from 3 to 22 years of age. Special Education is specialized instruction and services provided to students at no costs to parents or families to meet the unique needs of a child with a disability.

Excalibur Charter schools offers special education and related services to identified eligible student's grades k-12 to allow successful access to learning and their education. Students aged 0 to 5 will be referred to local support agencies as required under Child Find.

Special Education services may be provided in a variety of educational settings, but are required by IDEA to be delivered in the least restrictive environment possible.

Who is Eligible for Services?

A student must be identified as having a disability and that disability must adversely impact learning or access to learning and require specialized instruction or related services to be eligible. With this determination, the school and family collaborate to determine appropriate services, and supports for each individualized student through the development of an Individualized Education Plan (IEP).

Children with disabilities that do not need specialized instruction, but require accommodations in the classroom to access learning, may be eligible for an Accommodation Plan.

Child Find

What is Child Find?

Child Find is a component of Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and is an ongoing process of locating, identifying, and evaluating children between the ages of 0 and 21 who are suspected of a disability. "All children with disabilities, whether attending public or private schools, should be identified, located, and evaluated."

This service is provided to children with suspected disabilities, free of charge. Excalibur Charter School offers comprehensive special education services and referrals to eligible students ages five through 21 years. Children from birth up to age five with disabilities will be referred to appropriate agencies for services.
